

THE CHALLENGE FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND THE PROVINCE

- We don't know ...
 - the surfaces of the recreational cycling routes of the "Knooppuntennetwerk"
 - if there are road safety challenges on the routes
- We have silos in our administrations ...
 - some civil servants focussing only on cycling as a mode of transport
 - some civil servants only work on recreational cycling
- Parliament of the Province wants sports cyclists better informed ...
 - about what parts of the network can be used by sports cyclists







HOW THE COLLABORATION STARTED

- It started with a call from a municipal civil servant to the Provincial Cycling Agent ...
- Idea came up: organic process of creating more integration of the silos "recreational" & "cycling as transport" ...
- One concrete project: common inventory of the "underground" of the recreational network.



'Fietsmakelaar' (Bicycle Agent') Saskia Zwiers


- helps the municipalities to get cycling on their agenda,
- coordinates implementation of infrastructure measures
- brings together various local actors



INVENTORY OF THE UNDERGROUND OF THE RECREATIONAL NETWORK

- Idea at the start: let municipalities work with volunteers ...
- Province realised: "We could be in charge of the project ..."
- Province offers some financial support to municipalities for professional support (€ 5.000 / municipality)
- 9 out of 10 municipalities used the €
 5k vouchers
- Special attention to routes for sports cyclists (request from parliament)












"MEANDERING EXPERIENCE ROUTE ALONG A CYCLE HIGHWAY"












CHILDREN CYCLING ROUTE

- For children from 6-12 years; children play a game (solving a mystery)
- Promoting physical activity
- Startingpoints are nodes in the Fietsknoopuntennetwork
- Province subsidizes municipalities

IT STARTED WITH ... COLLABORATION OF FIVE MUNICIPALITIES

- 1st cycle highway project led to "What can we do in the whole province?"
- Realizing cycle highways based on (standard) agreements



PROMOTION OF USING (NEW) CYCLE INFRASTRUCTURE AND -NETWORKS

- Idea: let's involve the recreation sector to promote cycling
- Now: Collaboration of "Ons Brabant fietst" (promotes cycling to employers) & "Brabant Mobiliteitsnetwerk" (works on accessibility of the region)
- Budget for promotion of cycle highways = 1% of the investments



ONS BRABANT FIETST



- Works on promotion of cycling in the province of Noord-Brabant on behlave of the province and five bigger cities
- Collaborates with partners:
 - Breda University of Applied Sciences (BUas)
 - Routebureau Brabant
 - Several other municipalities in the province
 - Brabant Mobiliteitsnetwerk

LINKING CYCLE HIGHWAY F261 TO THE KNOOPPUNTENNETWERK

- Starting point for the idea: recreational and daily cycling enforce each other
- 1st step: Collaboration with companies to promote the F261
- 2nd step: Linking the F261 (red lines) by 9 nodes to the Knooppuntennetwerk to make the F261 visible to users of the knooppuntennetwork (green line), and vice versa.







Agreement on collaboration of the Province of Utrecht and five municipalities


- Details on the total budget of € 11 mln ...
- Parts of the municipal sections are paid by the municipalities for 35% ... the prvince pays 65%.
- The national government will partly subsidize the 35% of the municipalities ...

Special Agreement of the Province of Utrecht with three cities on realization by the province

- Municipalities give acces to the province to the ground ...
- The City of Amersfoort has to arrange the use of ground owned by a third party ...
- The province arranges the permits to build ...

23% of the cyclists use the F1 for recreational bike rides!








The challenges:

- The gap between policies for cycling as a mode of transport and for recreational cycling
- (Often) silos in administrations
- Cycle networks cross borders of municipalities and regions
 - Collaboration of different authorities need structures
- (Often) Lack of knowledge about the current infrastructure and safety issues of networks for recreation





What does work?:

- Identifying common interests of different authorities and in different policy fields
- Using existing or creating structures for collaboration of different authorities
- Money works ...
 - Collaboration across the borders of silos in administrations
- Cycling promotion supports goals in different policies ... a good start for collaborations





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
